OHSRA RODEO:

Oregon High School Rodeo has 7 weekends of rodeo encompassing 14 preliminary rodeos. Each rodeo weekend holds two rodeos. The rodeos are produced throughout the state by individual rodeo clubs in the area the rodeo is produced.

There are no minimum or maximum amount of rodeos you can compete at. Points are tallied from each rodeo as a qualification to the State Finals Rodeo. The top 10 placings in each event will get points. 1st place at each rodeo will receive 10 points and so on with 10th place receiving 1 point. OHSRA will count your best 8 rodeos in each event to qualify to state finals. Max of 80 points going into state finals. The top 20 in each event will qualify for state finals.

Each member of OHSRA has an opportunity to join their regional club in their area to be part of a club and help produce a rodeo in their area. OHSRA membership offers a discount to membership to students who join a club, others are considered independent members and membership dues are higher for them.
